
Bug # 1

Title: Bug related to “Completed date range” field while searching a work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Try to select “Completed date range”

Unable to select dates properly as Calendar display is not proper. Please refer the screenshot below:




Bug # 2

Title: Bug related to “Assigned to” field while searching a work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders

Pre filled text in textbox “Assigned To” is written as “Select Service...” which is incorrect. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 3

Unable to select any item from “Assigned to” textbox as no item is getting displayed even after searching a lot. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 4

Steps to reproduce

Unable to select any item from “Assigned to” textbox as no item is getting displayed even after searching a lot. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 5

Title: An Internal error appears while adding a new work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Select vehicle
4. Enter very long text in "Text" field
5. Click on "Save" button

An Internal error appears as shown in the screenshot below:




Bug # 6

Title: Bug related to dates range while adding a new work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Select vehicle
4. Select "Start Date" earlier than "Issue Date"
5. Click on "Save" button

User should not be allowed to save the work order instead a pop up message should appear stating that "Start Date cannot be earlier than Issue Date". Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 7

Title: Bug related to "Total Cost" field while adding a new work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Select vehicle
4. Enter values in "Total Labor Cost" and "Total Parts Cost" fields
5. Enter 0 in "Tax%" and "discount %" fields
6. Enter 0 in "Total Cost" field
7. Click on "Save" button

A pop up message should be displayed to the user stating that "Total Cost" cannot be less than the sum of "Total Labor Cost" and "Total Parts Cost", presently user is allowed to save the work order with these invalid values.




Bug # 8

Title: Bug related to sorting facility while editing a work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Actions" button for any work order
3. Select "Edit" button
4. Scroll down the page

Ascending and descending sorting facility is not available on field names as shown in the screenshot below:




Bug # 9

Title: Text appearance not good on editing a work order with a long Text field

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Actions" button for any work order
3. Select "Edit" button
4. Scroll down the page
5. Click on "Add new" button
6. Select service
7. Enter long text in "Notes" field
8. Click on "Save" button

Text is going out of the window as it is getting displayed in one line, it should be displayed in multiple lines. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 10

Title: Internal error occurs while editing a work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Actions" button for any work order
3. Select "Edit" button
4. Scroll down the page
5. Click on "Add new" button
6. Select service
7. Enter 10000 value in "Labor Rate" field
8. Click on "Save" button

Internal Error appears as shown in the screenshot below:





Bug # 11

Title: Unable to read a PDF file added using “Add a file” option while editing a work order

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on “Actions” button for any work order
3. Select “Edit” button
4. Click on “Add a file” option
5. Select a file of PDF type
6. Click on Open
7. PDF file will be displayed as added
8. Now click on the file name to download it
9. After downloading, try to read the file

User is unable to read a file that is added using “Add a file” option. Please refer to the screenshots below for more details:


Title: Bug related to adding a file of docx and xlsx type while editing a work order


Steps to reproduce

1. Select Vehicle Maintenance -> Work Orders
2. Click on "Actions" button for any work order

3. Select "Edit" button
4. Click on "Add a file" option
5. Although the folder contains docx and xlsx files but they are not getting displayed by default
6. Now select all files instead of custom files
7. Now docx as well as xlsx files are also getting displayed, ideally these files should be displayed by default because these files are of valid type


Bug # 13

Title: Bug related to dates range while adding a new Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Enter all the mandatory fields
4. Enter "Insurance Valid Until" and "Purchase Date" such that Insurance Valid Until date is earlier than Purchase Date
5. Click on "Save" button

A message should pop up stating that "Insurance valid until" date cannot be earlier than "Purchase Date"




Bug # 14

Title: Bug related to value in “Year” field while adding a new Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on “Add new” button
3. Enter all the mandatory fields
4. Enter 3000 in “Year” field
5. A message is displayed in Red color below the field name that “Please enter a value less than or equal to 2100.”

But this is incorrect as a Truck in year 2019 cannot be of year 2100 instead of this Red color message, a new message should be displayed stating the user that “Value in “Year” field cannot be older than current year”. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 15

Title: Bug related to dates range while adding a new Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Enter all the mandatory fields
4. Enter value in "InService Date" field earlier than "Purchase Date"
5. Click on "Save" button

A pop up message should be displayed stating the user that InService date cannot be earlier than Purchase date. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 16

Title: Bug related to "File" field while editing details of an already existing Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on "Actions" button for any truck from the list
3. Select "Edit" option
4. Select "Files" tab
5. Select a file of PDF/docx type
6. Click Open

The Type field is not displaying anything for PDF file which is not correct. Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 17

Title: Bug related to dates range while adding a new Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Enter all the mandatory fields
4. Enter "Plate Expiration" earlier than "Purchase Date"
5. Click on "Save" button

Truck details should not be saved instead a validation message should be displayed to the user stating that "Plate Expiration" cannot be earlier than "Purchase Date". Please refer to the screenshot below:




Bug # 18

Title: Bug related to value in “Make” field while adding a new Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on “Add new” button
3. Enter all the mandatory fields
4. Enter 4000 in “Make” field
5. Click on “Save” button

User should not be allowed to save a truck that has make year of future, this is incorrect.



Bug # 19

Title: Bug related Prices field while adding a new Truck

Steps to reproduce

1. Select Administration -> Trucks
2. Click on "Add new" button
3. Enter all the mandatory fields
4. Enter "Purchase Price" less than "Sold Price"
5. Click on "Save" button

User should not be allowed to save the truck details with "Purchase Price" less than "Sold Price" instead a message should be displayed stating that "Purchase Price" cannot be less than "Sold Price". Please refer to the screenshot below:
